Wednesdays We pray for the relocation of the present girls; and for the necessary preparatory building work.


Thursdays We give thanks for all our supporters, old and new, and for their continued prayers and encouragement; for further fundraising through

Construction Report

Build on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone. Ephesians 2.20

A new goal has now been reached in our quest to complete the first floor accommodation areas. Tiling and finishes to the kitchen preparation and large dining room areas including electrical work, heating services and decoration have now been achieved.

The welfare and security of the Lazarus girls and staff is a major priority of the "Friends" and the Palestinian Social Services.

Thanks to your fantastic fundraising, donations, sponsorship and further grants this has now allowed the charity to embark on the protection of the new home by the commencement of installing security double doors to the basement, ground floor main entrance area and all fire escape routes to all floors and roof area.

Instructions have been forwarded out to our architect to commence the installation of security window guards to the ground floor windows and the completion of the external perimeter security fencing to the rear and sides of the building including flood lighting.

Costings are now being prepared for our next phase to partly complete the ground floor administration area and external landscaping including the erecting of the stone wall to the front entrance area complete with wrought iron security gates and CCTV to both the internal and external of the building. Once these costing have been received and funding has been secured work will commence and the charity will update our website and newsletter.

These grants, together with your fantastic fundraising donations and sponsorship, have moved the charity nearer to relocating the girls. The trustees would also like to

extend their gratitude to those who are supporting the charity in memory of a loved one. The new home will provide a memory book which will be on perminent display in a propioate place and available to all visitors to the home.

The charity has been informed by one of the executors of our dear sister in Christ Joan of a bequeathed legacy left for the Lazarus project. This may not be finalised until possibly early 2015. Of course we will keep all our supporters up to date with the generous legacy and other grants that may be available. Your prayers would be appreciated.
