
Tuesdays We give thanks for bishop Younan our patron and our future spiritual connection.

Construction Report

As the Easter newsletter reported the local Palestinian Authority has indicated to our Jerusalem Trustee Ibrahim Younan and our new local board they wished to see the fitting out of the remainder of the ground floor by the construction of the new clinic and kindergarten for the local community whilst providing essential humanitarian requirements for the local children and community. Home:

Home

Just to refresh the first floor is fully completed including the administration area to the ground floor. Our local board will continue to liaise with the Palestinian Authorities to achieve the operational occupancy.

As part of the boards remit, they will endeavour to procure local project funding for running costs, salaries and educational projects. The clinic and kindergarten will be self generating projects.

Clinic Update: Phase (2)



Work has now commenced of the formation of the clinic area. The works includes; block and concrete works to form the walls and ceilings. Plastering to walls and ceilings, insulation, wall tiling including aluminium frames which covers approx 40% of the much needed clinic.

We now need to raise funds for the completion of the mechanical and electrical works with a separate costing for specialist medical equipment.

As previously discussed the board has been advised that a doctor and nurse could be made available to run the clinics once it becomes operational.

This transfer does not modify any of the aims of the organisation which was simply completed to bring the charity up to date with appropriate governance so as to protect and support the charity in the future and in the work it has set out to achieve. This will not affect any of the work of the organisation and we will still undertake to update our supporters on all matters affecting the charity. Your ongoing support is very much appreciated and helps us immeasurably in achieving a safe place for the girls who will be in our care to live, learn and develop as you people who are at present times of great need.

With the assistance of our accountant the new charity will register with HMRC to comply to procure the gift aid donations and financial benefits these gifts give the "Friends.
