Update Report

As previously reported in our Easter 2019 newsletter, a number of schemes that were under review by the local board have identified the need for the following projects.

We are pleased to announce the programs which will be brought to fruition in 2020 are as follows:

Integration of children with specialist educational needs

After a number of meetings with Vision Association of Culture and Arts (VACA) a non political, non governmental organisation located in Bethany, a program exploring fields of shared practices was incorporated into the proposed kindergarten. This will integrate children with special needs through adapted programs to meet each child at their own individual point of need. Skills will increase self confidence and development through music, art and physical sports.

Proposed Clinic Facilities

Following meetings with our trustee Ibrahim A. Younan as well as the Jerusalem local board, an agreement has been reached with Augusta Victoria Hospital (AVH) Jerusalem which will see the provision of a doctor and nurse to attend to general health care at the clinic. Further agreements have been attained for a portable diabetes unit and a breast screening mammography unit. These specialist services with have a tremendous impact on countless lives of both young and old in the local community.

Witness to the Lords Blessings


Augusta Victoria Hospital (AVH) is a program of the Lutheran World Federation Department for World Services in Jerusalem. Today most of the patients served by (AVH) continue to be in social need and seeking life saving specialist care. The (AVH) provides screening, early detection and health care. (AVH) is the first and only hospital to provide radiation therapy for cancer patients in Palestinian Territories.

Senior Citizens Day Care

The local board has also identified the need for a senior citizens care centre, as this facility is not available in the local area. This project will enable the elderly to come and spend time during the day with useful activities whilst benefiting from accessing clinical medical care.

The "Friends" are continuing to raise funds for the continuation of the construction work.

It is with a very heavy heart that we announce the passing of one of our most dedicated trustees, Revd David Attfield.

Revd David served the charity as a loyal and dedicated trustee and spiritual leader for over 20years. Many churches and groups will have known him for his prayers and generosity. Revd David was an active board member.

A very spiritual servant of Christ, Revd David's life was of unfailing service, both as a parish priest for 17 years in Hull and Manchester as well as in Durham, where he remained highly engaged in academic study.
